6 H.C.R. 2009 International Symposiums

We have been holding International Symposium every year to share the knowledge about common issues both in Japan and European countries regarding home care and social welfare, in conjunction with H.C.R.Exhibition. We've invited specialists from Europe who provided lectures on case studies and current tasks in their countries.

Today, each developed country has been addressing the declining birthrate and aging population. Some European countries where the supports were provided for women to enter the labor markets, as well as the traditional gender role in family was reconsidered see an increase the birthrates.

At the symposium, we invited a specialist in the measurements against declining birthrates to consider the relations between birthrates and environment for child-raising. In exchanging opinions on the basis of current Japanese situation, participants could gain further understanding. In total, 188 people attended.
